Effective July 1, 2023

Members are encouraged to consider common sense, *respect for tradition*, modesty and the comfort of fellow members and their guests when making casual-attire decisions. It is preferred that our members dress-up rather than down when visiting the Club. While we expect that members will use good taste and judgment, the Board has directed Club Management to discreetly address and review any inappropriate casual attire decisions directly with the member to ensure that the Club maintains a casual environment that is enjoyable for everyone. The Club Management shall have sole discretion and authority in matters of appropriateness of attire. *Members will be deemed responsible for seeing that their guests are appropriately attired*.

*** Exceptions to the dress code will be theme parties or other designated and private events. Club Management will provide detail and approval prior to the scheduled event. Dress code is subject to change at any time.

Golf

- Proper golf attire at all times on golf course, putting greens and practice areas.
- PGA dress code is suggested.
- No denim, swim suites, cargo shorts or cargo pants with outside pockets
- Shirts must be tucked in and hats must face forward
- Collared or mock turtle neck shirts with sleeves is permitted
- No flip flops or open toe foot wear
- Metal spikes are not permitted on club grounds
- Members or guests not properly attired will be asked to comply with dress code while on club grounds
- Ladies golf attire will mirror the LPGA dress attire

Clubhouse

- Proper attire
- Hats off in upper floor for gentlemen
- Tasteful denim jeans and denim skirts permitted except in the Commonwealth dining room; exceptions for private parties in CDR and Ballroom
- Gentlemen-shirts tucked in except Tommy Bahama
- Swim suites are not permitted in club house area or locker rooms
- Gentlemen-no open toe sandals in club house; collared or mock turtle neck shirts only

Pro Shop Area

- Proper golf attire
- Tasteful denim jeans and denim skirts allowed
- No flip flops or open toe foot wear
- Gentlemen: Shirts tucked in except Tommy Bahama, no open toe sandals, collared or mock turtle neck shirts only
- No swim suits, cut offs, tank tops or tee shirts

PUB

- No swim suits, cut offs, tank tops or cutoff shirts
- No flip flops or open toe foot wear
- Tasteful denim and hats worn forward
- Tasteful/respectful tee shirts only

Lower Terrace Dining Area

Gentlemen-shirts tucked in except Tommy Bahama

Pool

- No cutoff shorts or cutoff shirts
- Pool changing areas are provided for members and guests
- Swim suites can be worn to the club parking areas and traveling to the pool
